Tuli Kupferberg's *1001 Ways to Live Without Working* was first published in 1961 by Birth Press and reissued by Grove Press in 1967. The German translation was printed as a single issue of Hubert Kulterer's journal, *Eröffnungen*, at Vienna in 1972. This is a reissue, slightly revised, of the Vienna edition and can be ordered directly from Stadtlichter Presse either in a handsome sewn-bound edition or as postcard-sized brochures (German and English) boxed with a stack of postcards of Heike Küster's woodcuts.
